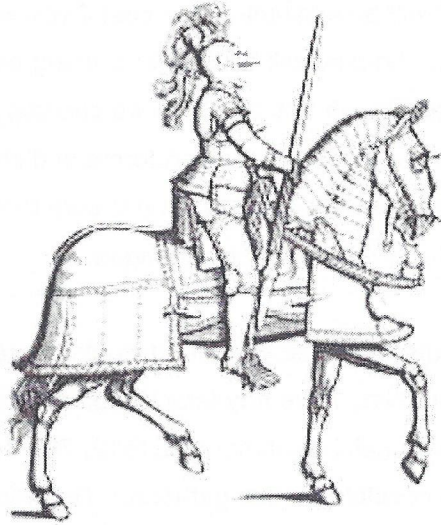


MCCALLUM CLASS OF 1968 REUNION ... TIME TO CELEBRATE OUR 50TH!
